

1. PROPOSED (ENORMOUS) PLANT AT INVERGARRY - The cemetery is the four parallel lines below the A87 road label bottom left.



1. Main boiler, turbine, generator and woodchip storage building.

This is where the woodchips are stored, fed into the boiler; steam is generated to drive the turbines and generators. The waste products from the combustion are then fed to the chimney stack.

2. Chimney Stack.

3. Heat dump radiators building – all the waste heat that “could” be used is fed into massive radiators with up to 1m diameter fans (over 170 in total ) to cool the exhaust steam. Additional noise and a reduction of overall efficiency of the plant. Making it not a COMBINED HEAT AND POWER PLANT

4. Weighbridge – So vehicles on arrival will be weighed in , then unloaded and weighed out

5. Weighbridge office

6. Entrance and exit from the site – directly on to the main road.

7. The now infamous Oak tree from the public meeting – that NEDL had a different view point from us.....
